SITE Santa Fe Announces SPREAD 2.0 Finalists

Santa Fe, NM October 3, 2011—SITE Santa Fe is delighted to announce eight finalists for the second SPREAD event to be held on Friday, October 28, 2011 at the Santa Fe Farmers Market. More than 40 applicants submitted proposals for consideration by the selection committee convened by SITE Santa Fe, and eight were nominated to be finalists. These artists will make presentations about their projects at a community dinner on Oct. 28, and the dinner guests will vote on their favorite project. The inaugural SPREAD event, held on March 18, 2011, raised proceeds from the door of over \$7,700 which was then given to the winning artist group, Meow Wolf. SITE hopes to match this auspicious launch with the second dinner in the series this year.

ABOUT SPREAD

SMALL GRANTS FOR BIG IDEAS

SITE Santa Fe's SPREAD is a micro-granting initiative that provides small grants for innovative projects conceived by New Mexico-based artists. SPREAD is a recurring public dinner designed to generate community-driven financial support to fund artistic innovation.

HOW SPREAD WORKS

At a large community dinner, diners pay a sliding scale entrance fee (starting at \$15), for which they will receive dinner and a ballot. During dinner, the SPREAD audience will hear short proposals from up to eight artists for innovative and yet-to-be-realized new projects. Diners will then cast their votes for their favorite project. At the end of dinner, the artist whose proposal receives the most votes will be awarded all the funds collected at the door to realize their project.

HOW TO ATTEND

The next SPREAD dinner will take place on Friday, October 28, 2011 at the Santa Fe Farmers Market. Doors will open at 7:00 pm. Halloween costumes are encouraged!

Because all the ticket proceeds will become the grant for the winning artist proposal, tickets are sold CASH ONLY on a sliding scale \$15 - \$50. Space is limited. Sorry, no phone or email reservations. All tickets will be sold in person at SITE in advance of the event on the following days:
